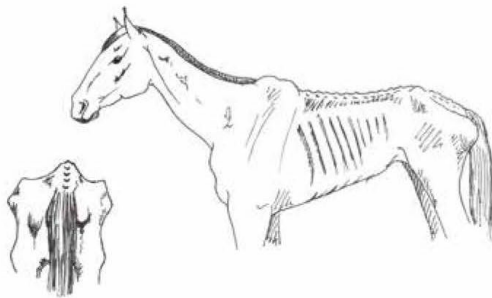

Body condition score and weight estimate every two weeks will enable you to spot changes in weight and condition more quickly than could be achieved by eye.

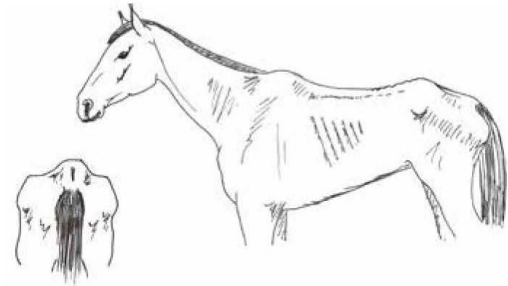

Body Condition Scoring - Horses

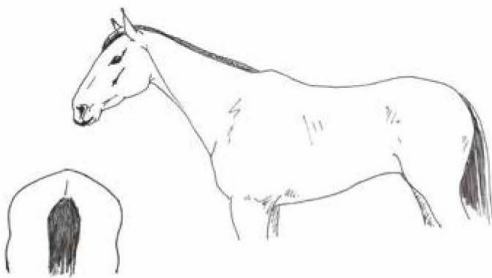
0. Emaciated



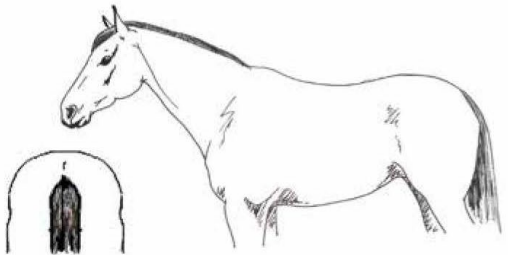
1. Poor



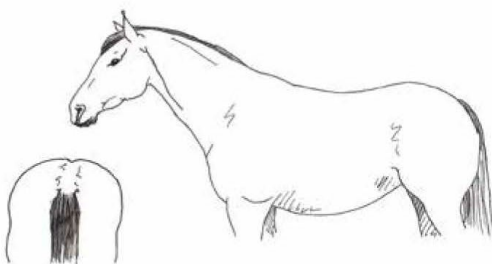
2. Moderate



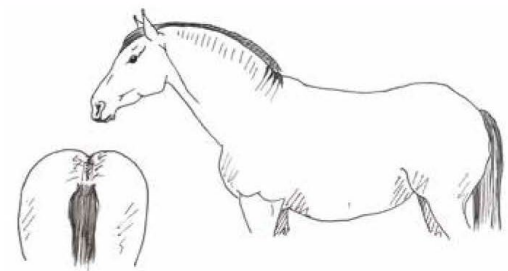
3. Good

Horse Weight Estimation:

To estimate an adult horse's weight, use the following formula:

$$\begin{aligned} & (\text{Girth measurement in cm}) \times (\text{Girth measurement in cm}) \times (\text{Length measurement in cm}) \\ & \div 11800 \\ & = \text{weight in kgs} \end{aligned}$$

...Or, utilise a horse weight tape which should be used around the horse's girth, where a roller would normally fit. You should use the same make of tape for weight measurement
