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PARTY GAME IDEAS 1

Some party game inspiration for individual players or teams

FIND A LETTER

Ask players to search out items around the stables starting with a letter. These letters can be made up of (for example):

HORSE NAME
THEIR NAME
A HORSE BREED
HORSE COLOUR

For fairness all words should have the same amount of letters

ie

P - A - B - L - O

Pony Nut - Apple - Brush - Leadrope - Oats

PIN THE PART ON THE HORSE

Using sticky notes (or similar) write down parts of the ponies body and ask players to identify them by sticking the note in the right place. Team with the most right wins!

TWO LEGS CLEAR ROUND

Set up a jumping course of no more than 18" and send the players round one at a time on foot and against the clock to see who can get a clear round in the fastest time. You can even do a relay version too!

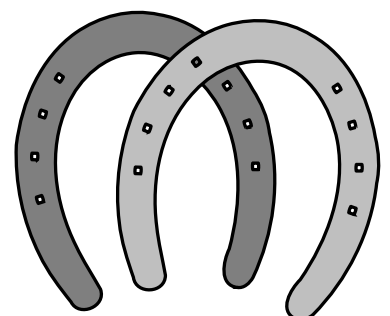
HUNT THE PONY

A horse themed treasure hunt. Hide small horse figures around the yard and send the players off to find them. You can also add clues for them to follow. First player or team to find all of theirs wins!

TACK SCRAMBLE

Get similar basic snaffle bridles. Ask each player or team to dismantle them and put them back together correctly against the clock. Fastest wins!

We all know you need to be super sensible with equestrian games. These games can all be adapted to the skill and age of your guests. Have fun, but be safe!





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PARTY GAME IDEAS 2

Some party game inspiration for individual players or teams

"PONY" SAYS

A horse version of Simon Says. Choose a popular pony name (to use instead of Simon) and give instructions like:

"PAT THE PONY"

"CANTER"

"BRUSH THE MANE"

"WAVE AT YOUR INSTRUCTOR"

"RISING TROT"

Anyone who does the action when you don't say "Pony Says" is out!

This can be done when mounted to using actions and transitions.

PONY PREP

Give each player or team a pony and grooming equipment. Give them 15/20 minutes to get the pony "show ready" and judge who is best. You can even give them extra decorations and accessories (and even sparkly or glitter products and a horn for unicorn parties!)

WHICH PONY?

Print out photos of a number of ponies on the yard and stick one to each players back. The players have to ask other players to guess which pony they are by asking questions to help identify.

A point given for each player who guesses correctly in 10 questions or less and nbonsu point if guessed correctly with 5 questions or less.

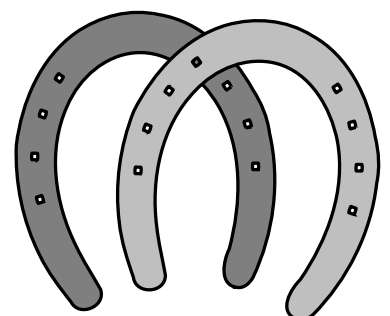
MUSICAL JOCKEYS

Similar to musical statues- ask players to mimic walk, trot or canter in the arena. They must freeze on the spot when you say 'HALT'. If they move, they are out!

MUSICAL BALES

Musical Chairs with small hay or straw bales in their place!

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PARTY GAME IDEAS 3

Some party game inspiration for individual players or teams

ARENA ANSWERS

To be played in the arena. Ask an equestrian themed question and give three answers- one correct and two false. Assign each answer a different letter of the school. Players must run to the letter for their answer of choice. If they run to the wrong letter- they are out. Last player standing wins.

Questions could be about ponies or instructors in your school, tack, grooming kit, breeds, colours... there are lots of opportunities.

WHATS IN THE BOX?

Get a few cardboard boxes and cut a small hole in one side, big enough to fit an arm through. Place in the boxes items that the players have to guess what they are. This could be grooming equipment, tack items, anything small enough to fit in the box. Team with the most right answers wins.

WHEELBARROW RACES

A very topical and traditional party game to be played in pairs or teams!

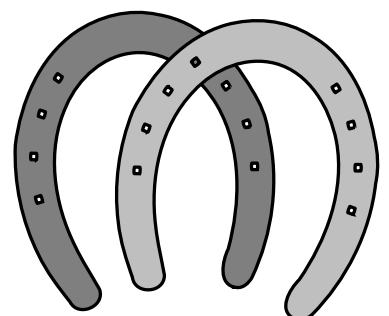
SCAVENGER HUNT

Give each player or team a list of 8 or 10 items they need to find on the yard and a bucket to put them in. They need to find corresponding items and fastest to return with correct items wins! IE ask for:

A SOFT BRUSH
SOMETHING BLUE
SOMETHING A HORSE EATS

Each list should be different, but requesting similar items. The team who fulfills the list first wins

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UNICORN PARTY GAME IDEAS

Some party game inspiration for individual players or teams

"UNICORN" SAYS

FIND THE RAINBOW

A rainbow themed treasure hunt. Hide small rainbow pictures (could be printed on card) around the yard and send the players off to find them. You can also add clues for them to follow. First player or team to find all of theirs wins!

UNICORN PIÑATA

Piñatas in the form of unicorns are readily available. Players take it in turn until the unicorn drops its presents

UNICORN PREP

Give each player or team a pony and grooming equipment. Give them 15/20 minutes to get the pony "unicorn ready" and judge who is best. You can even give them extra decorations or accessories (and even sparkly or glitter products and a horn!)

PIN THE TAIL ON THE UNICORN

A Unicorn version of the classic 'pin the tail on the donkey'. Make an elaborate Unicorn Tail using coloured ribbon. Can be done to 'pin the horn' as well.
