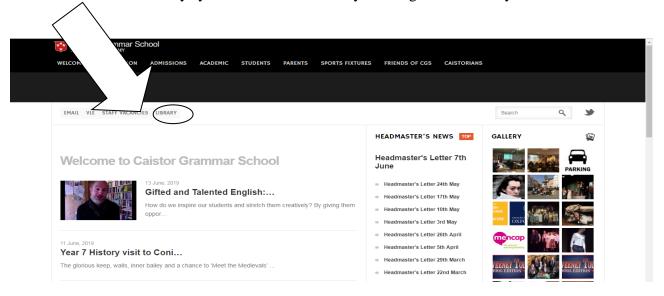
## **Accessing the Heritage Library System**

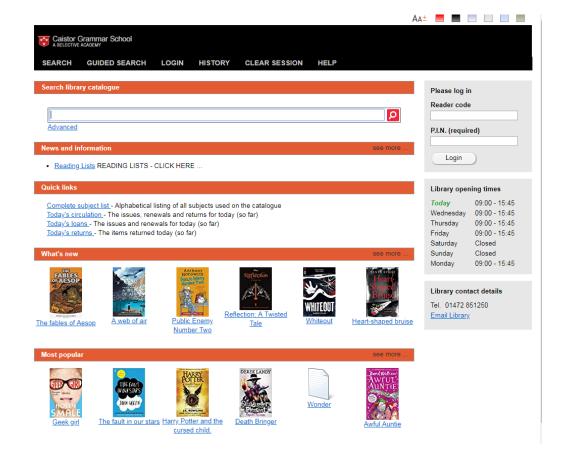
A view of the school library system can be accessed by clicking on the Library link on the school website.



This takes you to Heritage Online. This top level view gives access to all parts of the enquiry system. These include:

Reading Lists – both subject and key stage recommendations
What's new – a selection from the to the library catalogue additions from the past 90 days
Complete Subject Index - useful for non-fiction searches by topic.

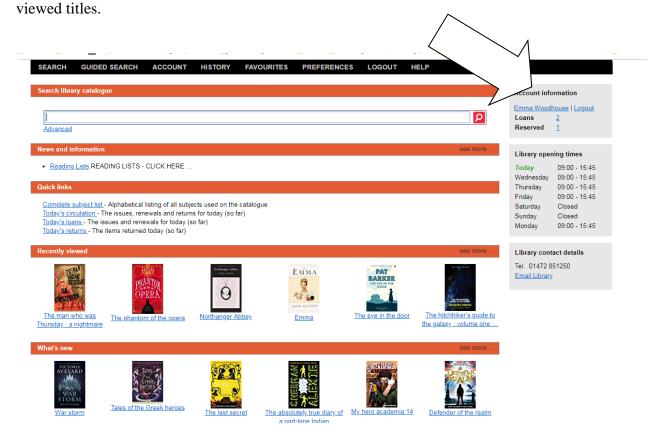
The search bar allows for enquiries by author, title, or keywords. Complex searches can also be executed here.



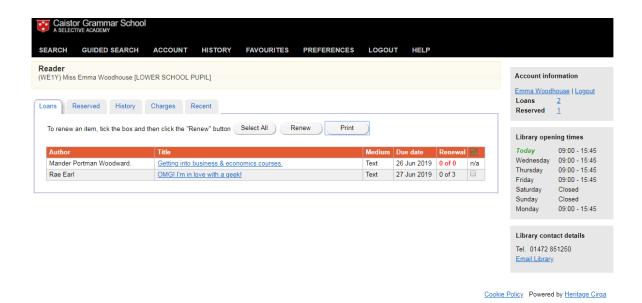
On the right hand side of the screen, students can enter their Reader Code and PIN (the pin is their date of birth in six figure form). There is also a link to email the librarian, should you have any comments or queries.

Once this data has been entered, the screen changes to a view as shown below.

Your account name is shown, along with a summary of current loans and reservations. Another change is that a new information bar appears on the main part of the screen, showing recently

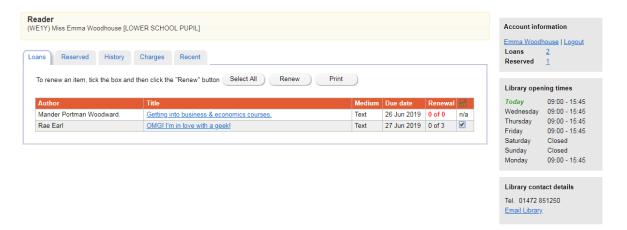


Clicking on the borrower's name, or the Loans link, will take you to the screen below.



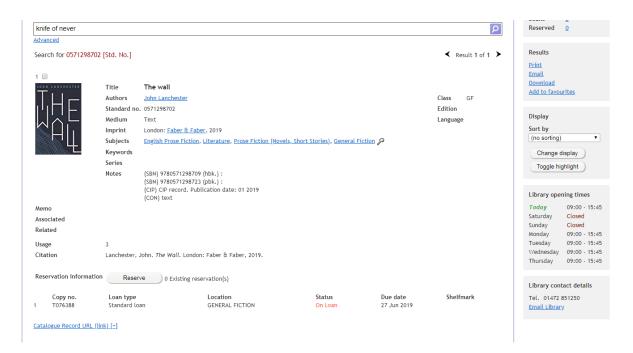
You will see that, where a title can be renewed, there is a tick box on the right hand side. Books can be renewed online up to twice, unless the title has already become overdue, in which case a small fine is payable, and the book needs to be renewed in person via the library.

To renew, just tick the box and press the renew button



You will see the date goes green, and changes to a new, later renewal date. This is generally two weeks from the date of renewal, the standard loan period.

If a title is out on loan, and you are logged in, it can be reserved online.

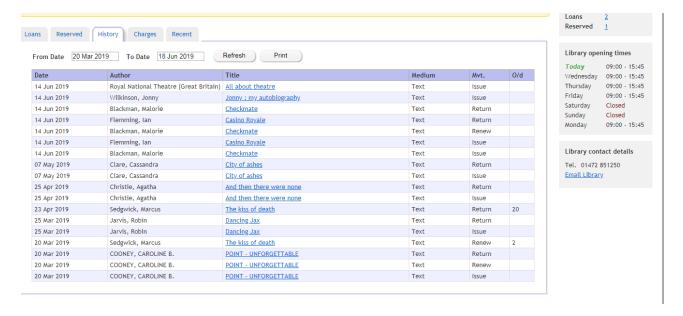

Simply click on the reservations button, you will see your reservations total increment by one, and also your place in the queue.



You can cancel a reservation in the same way you renew a book - tick the box by the title and press enter. The number of reservations decreases by one.

Selecting the user name from the main screen takes you the user's history.



The loans and reservation screens mirror the information already discussed. Clicking on the History tab enables you to view the student's borrowing record, including renewals and overdue books.

If a book does go overdue, a reminder is sent by email to the student after one week, similarly a second email is sent after two weeks. At 21 days overdue a letter is put in the student's register. A week later a letter is sent home.

Students have been shown how to use the Heritage system to locate books in the library, to save lists of favourite titles and set up their own saved searches.
