





Is an organisation that offers a variety of in-person and online work experience courses/career programmes, for those mainly aged 14-21 years (some state "any age") and who are keen on becoming doctors, surgeons, nurses, midwives and dentists

The costs for some of their programmes are very high so if interested, you will need to weigh up the pros and cons concerning whether it is worth it FOR YOU and decide, with family/carer support, if you/they wish to pay the fees required – check out what is included in the costs / how the programmes and fees differ / the deposit needed / how to pay in instalments, if appropriate and so on

Is a a free, virtual and interactive medical work experience programme, set up by the Royal College of General Practitioners (RCGP), is still running and recommended for those who are keen on a becoming a GP.
It is aimed at those aged 16 and over and consists of a series of 8 pre-recorded videos showcasing the roles of various members of staff that work in general practice – they estimate it should take between 2 and 2 and a half hours to complete but does not have to be completed in one go.

YOUNG PEOPLE TO BE TRAINED AS ENGINEERS, WELDERS AND TECHNICIANS IN MAJOR DRIVE

DWP SECRETARY LIZ KENDALL AND ENERGY SECRETARY ED MILIBAND HAVE JOINED FORCES TO BACK A 'CLEAN POWER ARMY' OF JOBS THAT ARE TO BE CREATED TO DELIVER CLEAN POWER BY 2030

An article in The Daily Mirror - 7th April 2025 revealed that "the DWP Secretary and Energy Secretary will be meeting up tomorrow with energy bosses to understand how they can "build and train the workforce of the future". Around 55,000 more jobs will be created by the end of the decade through plans to reform the National Grid alone. The government is driving forward with Regional Skills Pilots in the clean energy sector in Aberdeen, Cheshire, LINCOLNSHIRE and Pembrokeshire. Local partners will receive funding that could go towards new training centres, courses or careers advisers to support local people into industries such as welding, electrical engineering and construction.

Jobs supported by net zero sectors increased by 10% last year with the average annual wage across the sector at £43,000 - £5,600 higher than the national average, according to the latest Confederation of British Industry Economics figures"

Latest engineering and tech workforce data available

Our new workforce data reveals there are 6.4m people employed in engineering and technology roles in the UK, that's around a fifth of the total UK workforce at just over 19%. However, the data highlights there is still more to done before we have the diverse workforce needed for UK engineering and technology to thrive. Women remain the most underrepresented group, accounting for just 16.9% of the workforce.
