Greetham Retreat Holidays What we offer....

- Quality self catering accommodation with
 5 Cottages, sleeping 1 to 16 guests.
- Caravan Club Certificated Location with just 5 pitches and full facilities.
- All set in over 4 acres of natural grounds with ponds, woodland and wildflower meadows for guests recreation and enjoyment.

Where are we?

- Situated near Horncastle in the heart of the Lincolnshire Wolds AONB.
- Set in open countryside and close to a network of public footpaths and bridleways.
- Offering a tranquil and natural environment.
- We use nature as one of our main attractions and as a marketing tool.
- Offering guests with hectic lives a relaxing escape to the quiet of the countryside.

Our Vision...

- Retired from Leicestershire Police at 51, felt too young to do nothing.
- Had a dream to run and own a holiday let business with a small caravan site and wanted to work together.
- We were both townies & had no experience or knowledge of wildlife & conservation.
- But we both felt strongly about it and started scouring the country for something suitable that we could afford.
- We found Greetham Lodge in Lincolnshire; then bought it & moved in the summer of 2007.

This is what we bought, can you see our house in the background?



- A redundant barn or crew yard.
- It was full of hundreds of feral pigeons.
- Hence the title of this presentation
 'Pigeons to paying guests'



It was set in a 4 acre field of poor quality grass with little bio diversity





How we started...

- It took 12 months to get plans & permissions in place.
- Advice & small grants from Lincolnshire Wolds
 Countryside service to create wildlife pond & purchase seed for wildflower meadow.
- Lincolnshire County Council provided 650 native tree whips, protection tubes and stakes, plus mixed thorn hedgerow plants. We only paid half the cost.
- We funded everything else ourselves & spent the kids inheritance!

Started by creating our natural grounds before starting the building conversion...


Excavated the wildlife pond in a damp patch in the field.





We planted all 650 tree whips...

This allowed them to establish & grow for a year before we opened for paying guests.



Barn conversion started in January 2009



- We project
 managed and
 helped out
 ourselves
 wherever
 possible.
 - The pond is now full with water with the newly planted tree whips in the foreground...

We chose names for each cottage & named them after women in our lives...

- Katie's Corner was named after our daughter 'Katie'.
- Maggie's Mews & Rose's Rest were named after Jeanette's mum, 'Margaret Rose'.
- Wendy's Wing was named after Rob's mum whose middle name was 'Wendy'.
- Laura's Loft was named after Rob's grandmother 'Laura' which is also our daughter Katie's middle name.

18 months later the conversion is all finished...

We opened for paying guests for the first time in July 2010.





Autumn of 2010 we built the caravan site...



- 6 weeks to build.
- Ash trees pollarded.
 - 5 hard standing pitches, access road & service point built.
- Opened just after Christmas 2010.

We use Nature as a primary marketing & promotional tool...

How we Signpost Nature

 Emails, Correspondence and In Person.

Initial contact shows nature links.

- Promote upcoming events via own
 Website, Twitter and Facebook pages.
- Encourage guest to share their own pictures etc.

Tailor Signposting to what they are looking for!

- Our guests are Couples, Families, Walkers, Cyclists, Dog owners, Peace & quiet seekers, Active individuals, Stargazers & photographers etc...
 - Most want Nature attractions and venues to visit.
 - Recommend and advise what is available, what is offered, when is it open and how to get there. EXAMPLE: Dog owners to quieter beaches for space and freedom without conflict (e.g. Theddlethorpe).

Guests with kids...

- After a long journey, cooped up in the car! Kids asking "are we there yet"?
- Use this to your advantage:-
- Encourage them to explore the grounds.
- Spot the wildlife Moorhen chicks on the pond, butterflies in the wildflower meadows.
- Pond dipping, bug hotel or nature detective sheets.
- Suggest visits to farm parks, seal sanctuaries, bird watching, nature reserves, donkey sanctuary, The Deep, Coastal Country Park and there are so many more great places to visit too.




