

WATCHING TV / PROGRAMME CONTROL

ON SCREEN MENUS SELECTION AND ADJUSTMENT

Your TV's OSD (On Screen Display) may differ slightly from that shown in this manual.





Press **MENU** to display the option icons, and navigate to the desired one using the Up/Down/Left/Right arrow keys.



Press **OK** to select a menu option and move to the pop up menu.


- Press the MENU button to return to normal TV viewing.



1 Power Cord Socket

This TV operates on an AC power. The voltage is indicated on the Specifications page. Never attempt to operate the TV on DC power.

- ② HDMI/DVI IN input
 Connect an HDMI signal to HDMI IN.
 Or DVI(VIDEO) signal to HDMI/DVI port with DVI to HDMI cable.
- ③ RGB/DVI Audio Input Connect the audio from a PC or DTV.
- ETHERNET Input
 Ethernet port for the Freesat interactive service.
 (for future use)
- (5) RGB IN Input Connect the output from a PC.
- **6 SERVICE ONLY PORT**
- OPTICAL DIGITAL AUDIO OUT Connect digital audio to various types of equipment. Connect to a Digital Audio Component, Use an Optical audio cable.

Note: In standby mode, these ports do not work.

® Component Input

Connect a component video/audio device to these jacks.

- Euro Scart Socket (AV1/AV2)
 Connect scart socket input or output from an external device to these jacks.
- (ii) Satellite LNB Input Connect a satellite antenna cable.
- Antenna Input Connect a RF antenna or cable to this jack.
- PCMCIA (Personal Computer Memory Card International Association) Card Slot Insert the CI Module to PCMCIA CARD SLOT. (This feature is not available in all countries.)
- USB Input
 Connect USB storage device to this jack. (for MP3 or JPEG files)
- Audio/Video Input Connect audio/video output from an external device to these jacks.
- Headphone Socket
 Plug the headphone into the headphone socket.


FREESAT PROGRAMME TUNING (IN FREESAT INPUT - 2)

Switch to Freesat input using the FREESAT button.


(FREESAT button toggles between Freesat and Non-Freesat TV modes.)


If you select this function in Non-Freesat mode, the TV mode will be automatically switched to Freesat mode.

Use this to automatically find and store all available Freesat programmes. When you start auto programming, all previously stored service information will be deleted.









Select SETUP.

- If you have selected On in LOCK > Lock System menu, you will be prompted to enter your password to access. Use NUMBER buttons to input a 4-digit password.
- If you search the Freesat programme for the first time, your TV will attempt to detect the Freesat signal before entering your postcode.
- When the Freesat signal is detected, press the OK button to go to the next step.
- If the Freesat detection fails please check that the satellite cable are connected correctly.
- To stop the search, press the OK button during channel search.
- The freesat service uses the Astra2 satellites at 28.2° East.



Enter your full postcode including a space for local services.



Select Search.




Run Freesat Tuning.

The search results will appear.

The found programmes are automatically saved in order.

- Press the MENU button to return to normal TV viewing.
- Press the RETURN button to return to the previous screen.

The video function does not w	ork.
	Check whether the TV is switched on. Try another channel. The problem may be with the broadcast. Is the power cord inserted correctly into the mains? Check your antenna direction and/or location. Test the mains outlet by plugging another product into the same outlet.
-	Test the mains outset by plugging criteria. This is normal, the image is muted during the TV startup process. Please contact your service centre, if the picture has not appeared after five minutes.
- - -	Adjust Colour in menu option. Allow a sufficient distance between the TV and the VCR. Try another channel. The problem may be with the broadcast. Are the video cables installed properly? Activate any function to restore the brightness of the picture.
	- Check for local interference such as an electrical appliance or power tool.

QUICK MENU

Your TV's OSD (On Screen Display) may differ slightly from that shown in this manual. Q.Menu (Quick Menu) is a menu of features which users might use frequently.

Aspect Ratio: Selects your desired picture format.

For Zoom Setting, select 14:9, Zoom and Cinema Zoom in the Ratio Menu. After completing Zoom Setting, the display goes back to Q.Menu.

Energy Saving : Selects your desired Energy Saving


Picture Mode: Selects your desired Picture Mode.

Sound Mode: It is a feature to automatically set the sound combination which it deems the best for the images being watched. Selects your desired Sound Mode. (a) Audio : Selects the sound output.

Sieep Timer : Sets the sleep timer.

PR Fav. On/Off: Add the programme to the favourite list.

USB Eject : Select "Eject" in order to remove USB










Installing Batteries



- Open the battery compartment cover on the rear and install the batteries paying attention to the correct potanty.
- Install two 1.5V AAA batteries. Do not mix old or used batteries with new ones.
- Close cover.

When using the remote control, aim it at the remote control sensor on the TV.



WATCHING TV / PROGRAMME CONTROL

TURNING ON THE TV

- When your TV is turned on, you will be able to use its features.
- Firstly, connect the power cord pushing it firmly home and check the main power on the TV. At this stage, the TV switches to standby mode. (The power indicator on the TV illuminates red.)
- in standby mode to turn TV on, press the INPUT or PAV (Programme Up/Down) button on the TV or press the POWER, INPUT, PAV or NUMBER button on the remote control and the TV will switch on.

Initial Setting

This function guides the user to easily set the optimal viewing mode and tune the available channels. When you turn the TV on for the first time after purchase or performing the OPTION > Factory Reset, this function will begin automatically.

<Mode Setting>

- Select the mode for your environment. Each mode provides the optimal picture settings for each
- Select "Home Use" to use the TV in home.
- Select "Store Demo" to use the TV in store. Even if the user changes the picture setting, the TV will automatically reset to initial settings after a certain period of time.
- The mode (Home Use, Store Demo) can be changed in the OPTION > Mode Setting menu.

<Select Tuning>

- Select one of the three tuning modes Freesat & Antenna, Freesat or Antenna.
- After the Freesat signal is detected, enter your full postcode (including any spaces e.g. TW19 7RP).
- The Freesat service uses Astra 2 at 28.2° East, and Eurobird 1 at 28.5° East satellites.
- If new software is detected and installed, you can use the initial setting again.

<Auto Tuning>

First tunes the Freesat programmes, then Digital and analogue terrestrial programmes.

- a. If you close without completing the initial setting, the Initial Setting menu can be displayed again.
- b. Press the RETURN button to return to the previous screen.
- c. For those countries without confirmed DTV broadcasting standards, some DTV features might not work. depending on the DTV broadcasting environment.

PROGRAMME SELECTION

Press the PAV (Programme Up/Down) or NUMBER buttons to select a programme number.

VOLUME ADJUSTMENT


Press the ∠ + or - button to adjust the volume.

If you wish to switch the sound off, press the MUTE button. You can cancel this function by pressing the MUTE, -+ , - or AV MODE button.
