- February Start of the Covering Season (Northern Hemisphere) - (February 15th to July 15th)
- April Peak of the breeding season (Northern Hemisphere) Auctioneer visits (Yearling sales) Paddock management (April to September)
 - Breeze Up sales

- JulyStart of Yearling Prep. (July to October)WeaningVaccination programmes start (All stock)
- September Primary Yearling sales September & October Mare pregnancy checks




