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1ST4SPORT LEVEL 3 AWARD IN THE TRANSPORT OF HORSES ON LONG JOURNEYS

This qualification is for you if you'll be involved in transporting horses on long journeys (over 65km or eight hours). You should have experience of working with and handling horses, and you'll need to provide a horsebox for your assessment.

Choose the right unit for your role:

- Attendant (you should be at least 16 years of age)
- Attendant/Driver (you should be at least 17 years of age and hold a driving licence for the appropriate vehicle class)

You will be assessed through:

- a multiple-choice exam
- observation of your skills in loading, unloading and transporting horses.



1ST4SPORT LEVEL 3 AWARD IN THE TRANSPORT OF HORSES BY ROAD ON SHORT JOURNEYS

Choose this qualification if you'll be involved in transporting horses on short journeys (under 65km or eight hours). You should be at least 16 years of age and have experience of working with and handling horses.

You will learn about:

- the principles of transporting horses by road on short journeys.
