 - Broodmares
 - Stallions
 - Change of Ownerships



30 DAY FOAL NOTIFICATION

- Weatherbys to be notified of birth and location of a foal within 30 days of birth using the GSBO platform
- First step in being able to trace a Thoroughbred throughout its life
- Introduced by the 'Thoroughbred Industry Meeting' who aim to improve welfare and traceability of Thoroughbreds in GB

 - Ownership
 - Medication and Vaccinations
 - Movements

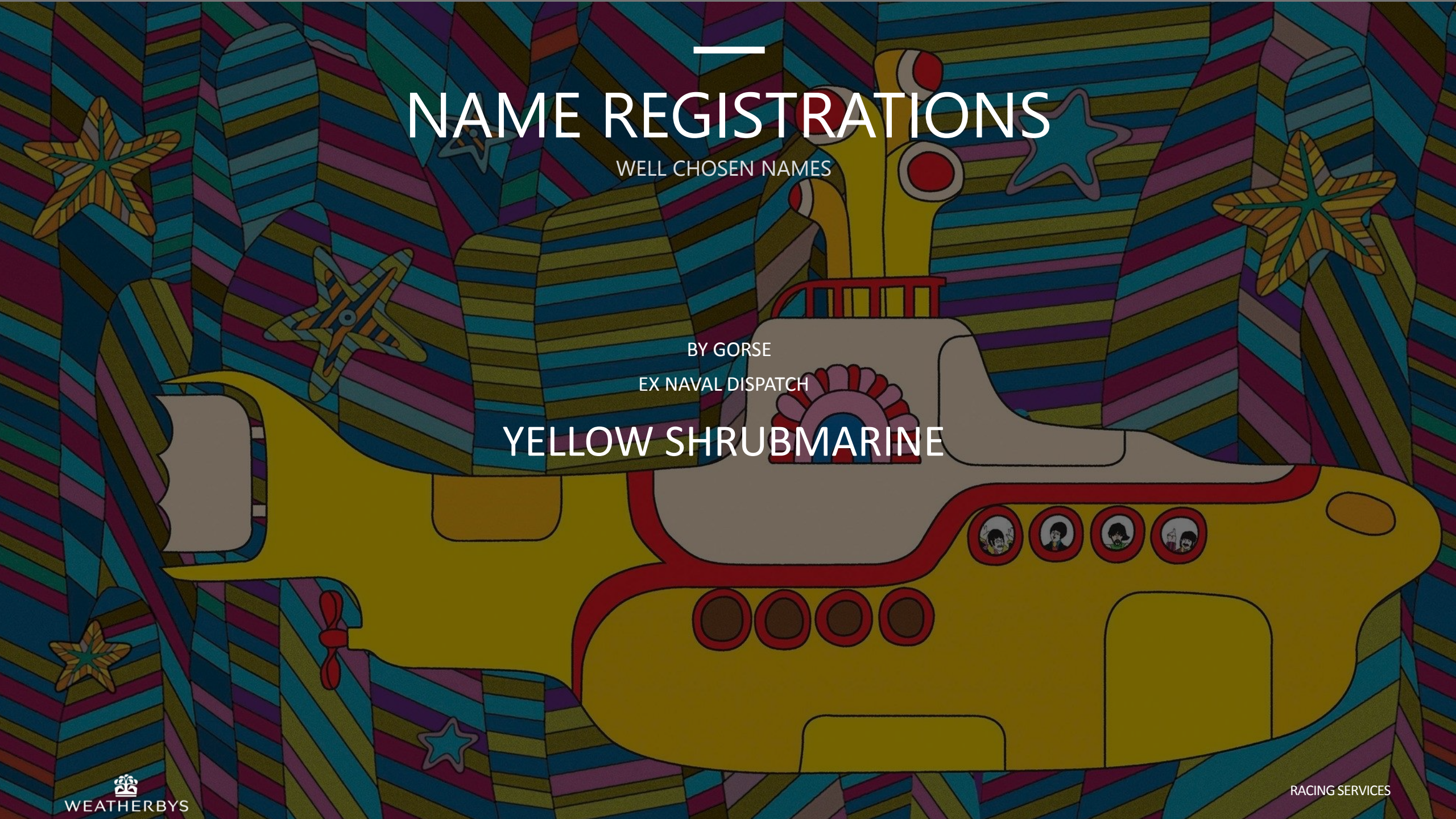

REGISTRATION AS AN OWNER



Anyone wishing to have a horse in Training in GB must be registered on the BHA's database



Credit and identity checks are conducted on all applicants



Online registration, through BHA website



Efficient - potentially registered within 24 hours



Minimum age is 16 but those under the age of 18 must have a financial guarantor



OWNERSHIP REGISTRATIONS

THE FIVE OWNERSHIP TYPES

1 SOLE OWNER

For people wishing to own a horse outright.

2 COMPANY

For people who wish to own a horse under the name of a company or business.

3 PARTNERSHIP

- For two or more people
- All members must be registered owners
- Ability to define the % owned by each member

4 SYNDICATE

- For larger groups of people
- Managed by the syndicator(s)
- Only the syndicator(s) must be registered owners

5 RACING CLUB

- Syndicate members must be listed
- For those who want to pay a subscription to experience ownership
- The club, rather than the members, own the horse.
- Managed by the club manager(s)
- Only the club manager(s) must be registered owners
- Club members do not need to be listed

AUTHORITY TO ACT

Where an owner appoints a trainer to act on their behalf, allowing them to:



Sign and complete registration forms



Make entries, declarations, to run jockey bookings

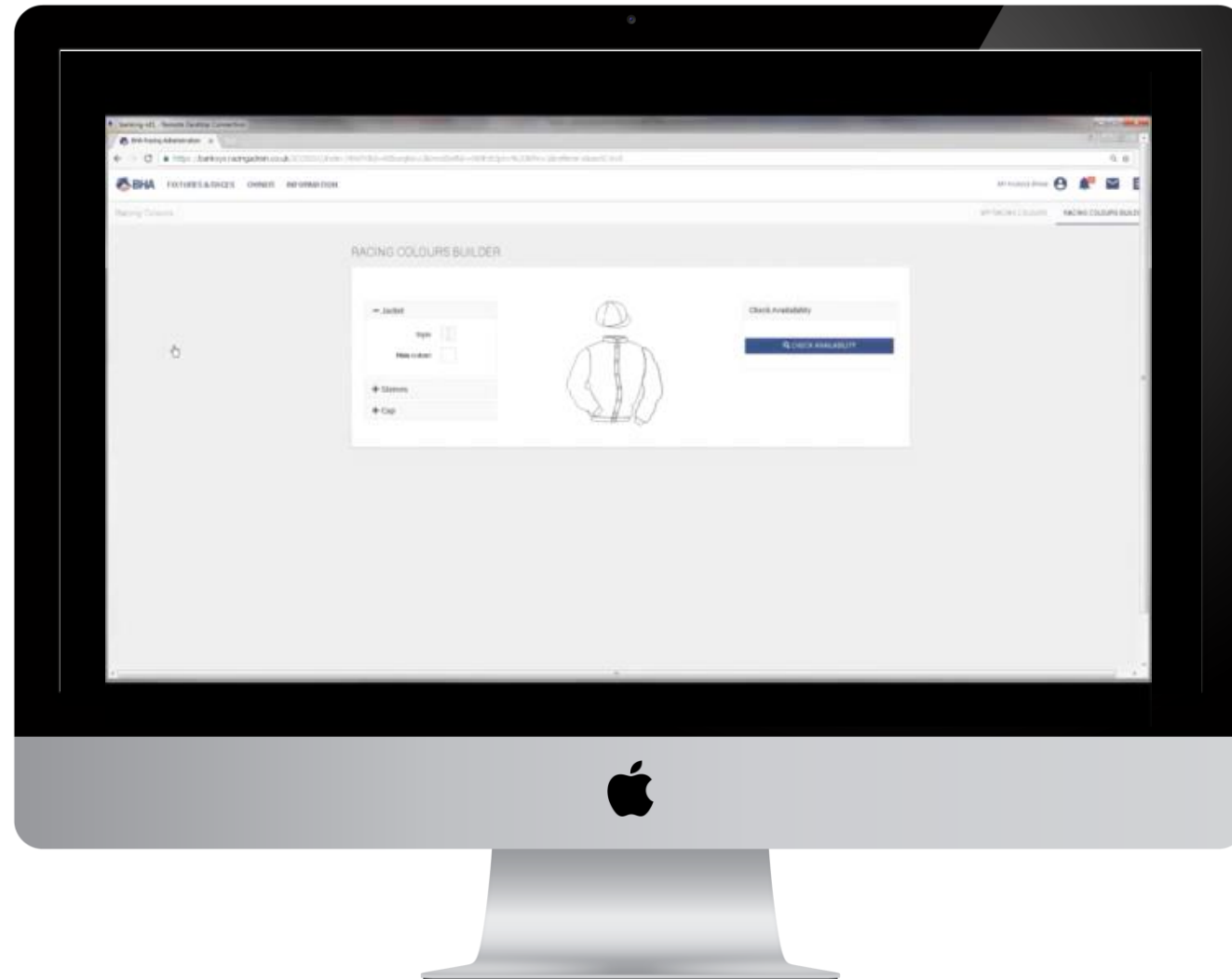


Terminate registrations such as Partnerships or Syndicates

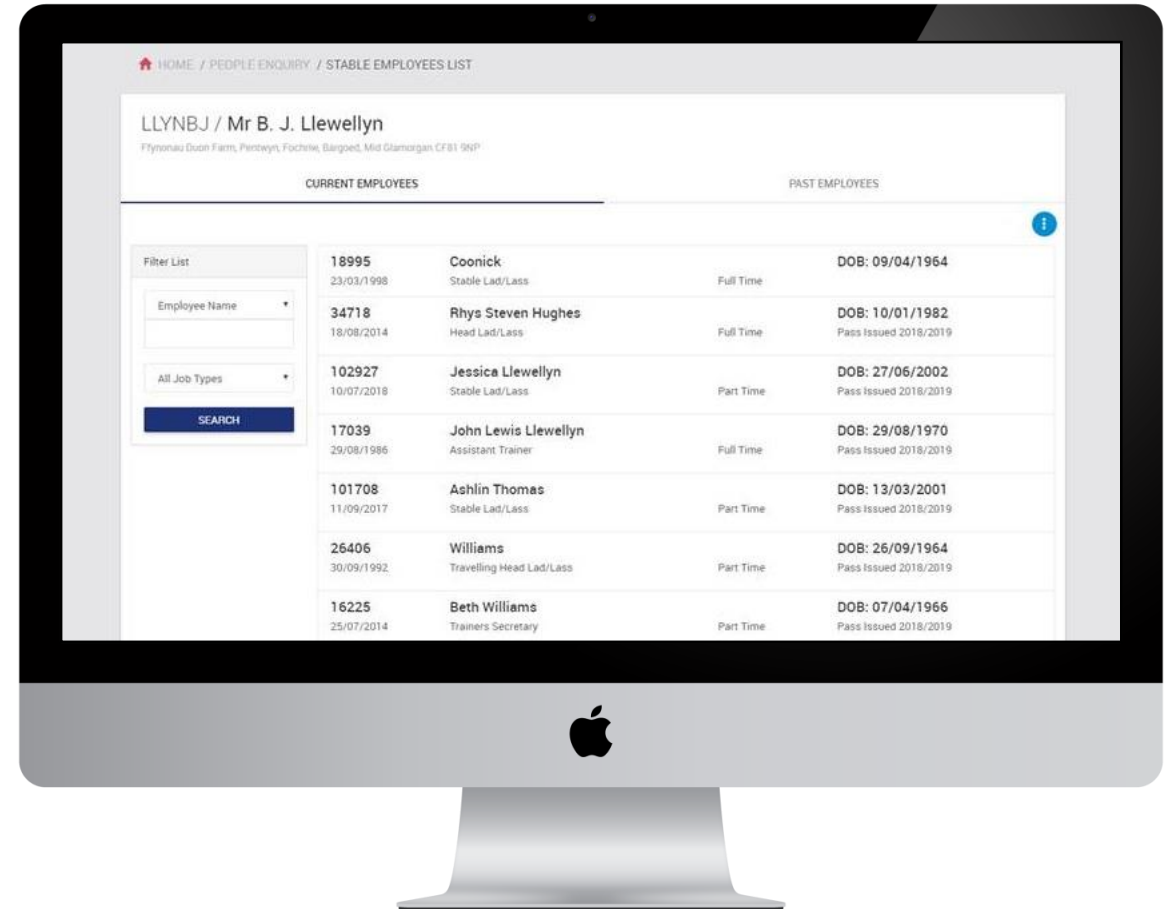
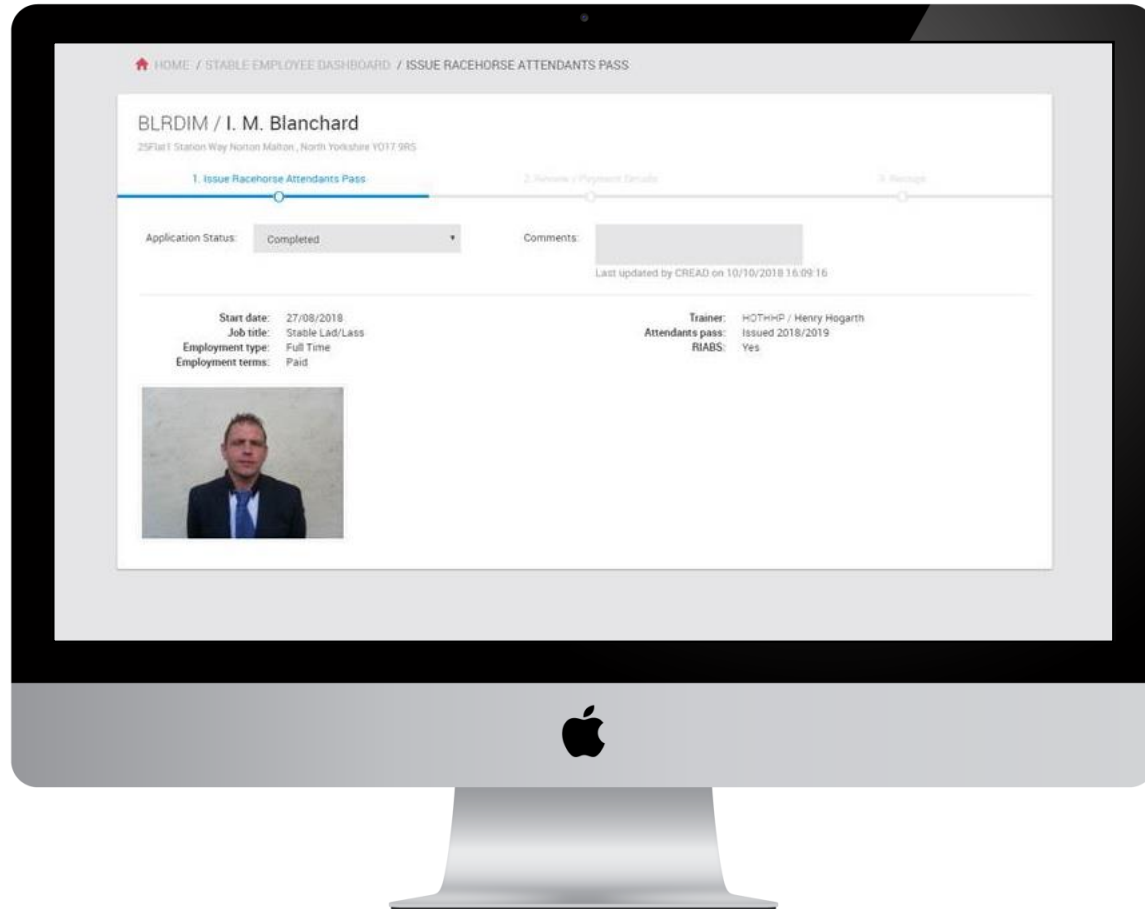

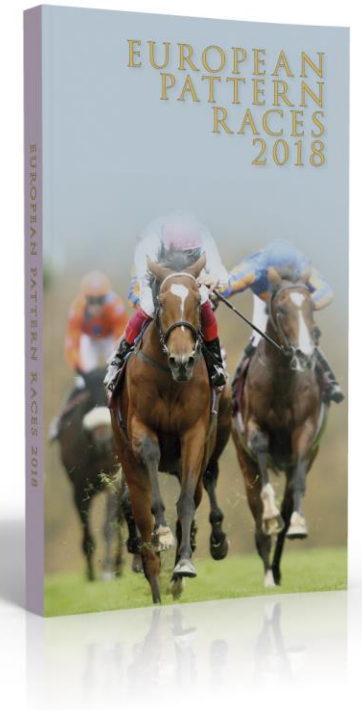
