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Auction Conditions

Buyers Premium: Purchasers shall pay 20% commission inclusive of VAT of the hammer price. Under the Auctioneers' Margin Scheme, VAT cannot be reclaimed.

Payments of Accounts: Payment for all lots purchased must be made in full on day of sale & methods are: **Cash** - To a maximum of 10,000 Sterling. **Cheque** - Cheques must be supported by a letter of reference from your bank or a cheque guarantee card covering the sum of your purchase. **Card** - Debit Card Only. **Banker's Draft** - It is the responsibility of the purchaser to make prior arrangements regarding method of payment before attending the auction. For persons unknown to the Auctioneers, their lots will be impounded until the Auctioneers have cleared funds.

Bidding: At the fall of the hammer the highest bidder shall be the purchaser but if a dispute arises as to the identity of the highest bidder the Auctioneers will confirm the identity of the highest bidder or the lot will be put up again and resold. No person will be allowed to retract their bid once accepted by the Auctioneers but the Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse a bid from any person without giving reason.
